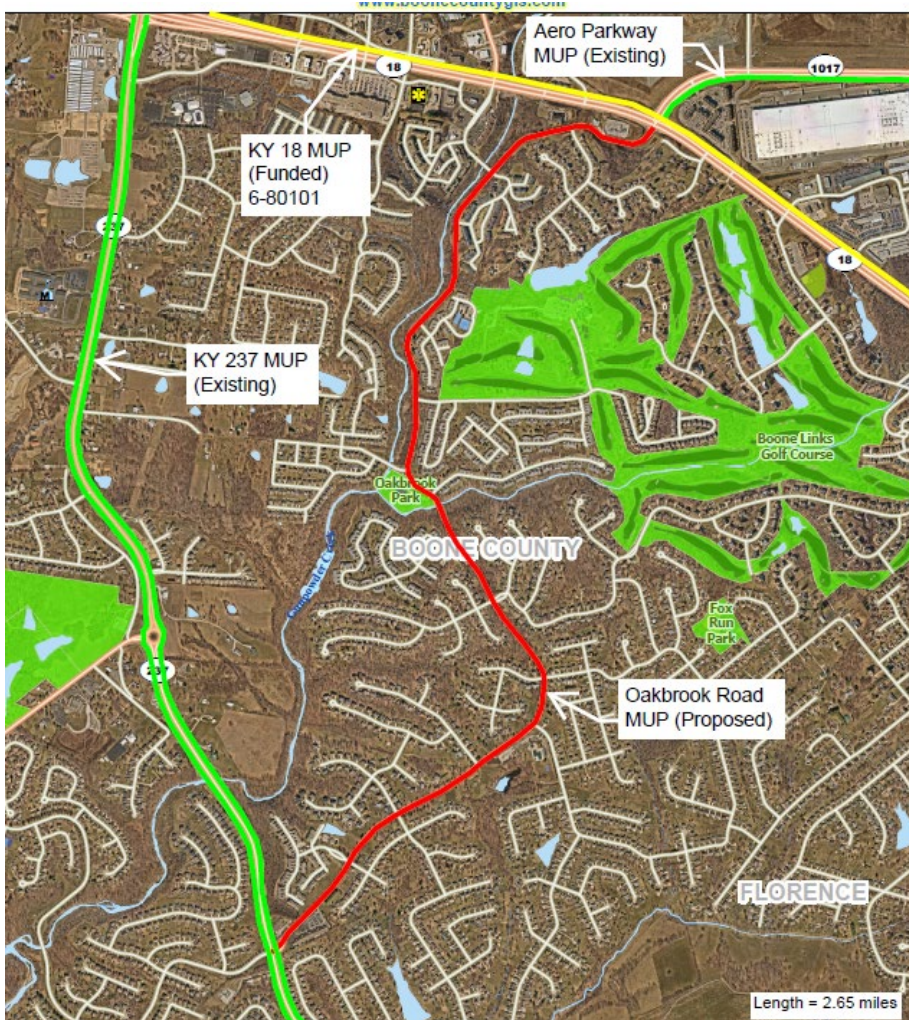

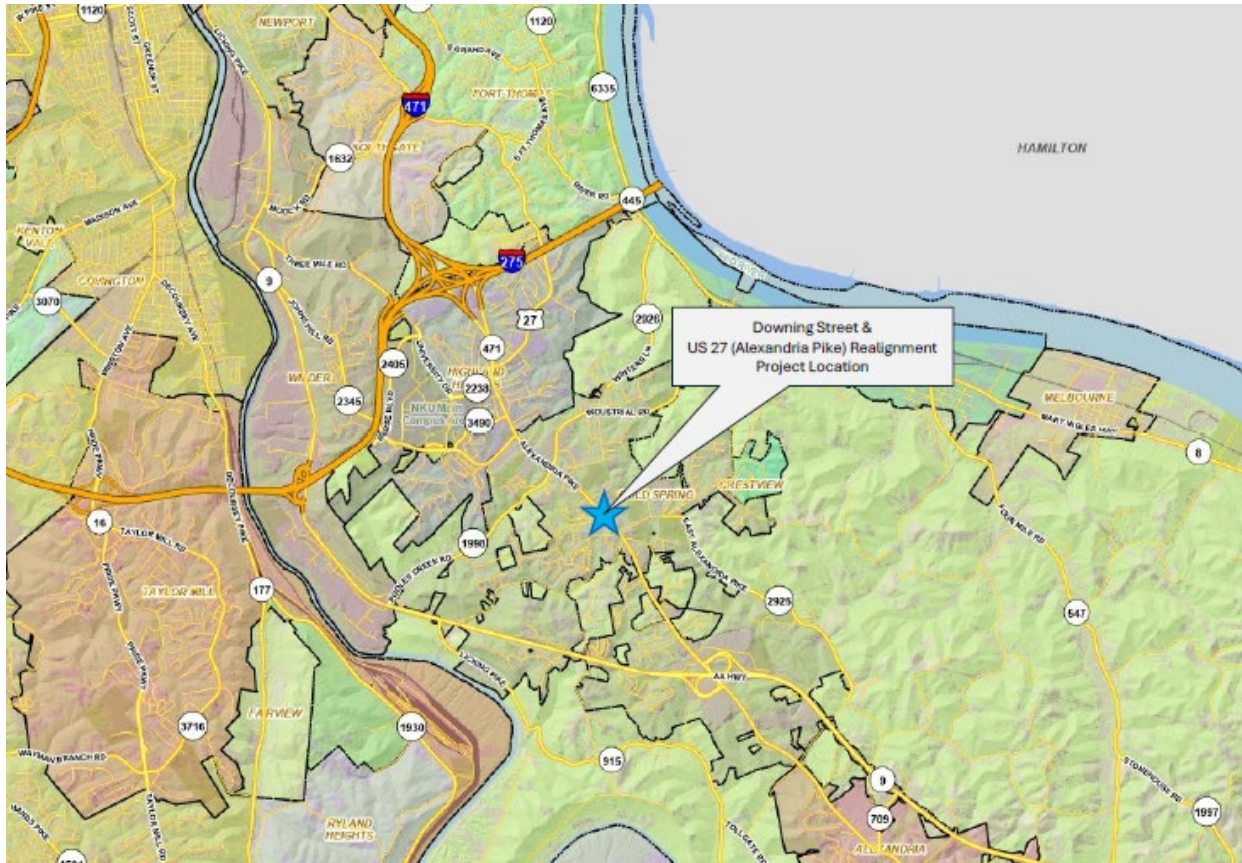
Boone Co-Oakbrook Road Multi-Use Path

- Total Length = 2.65 miles

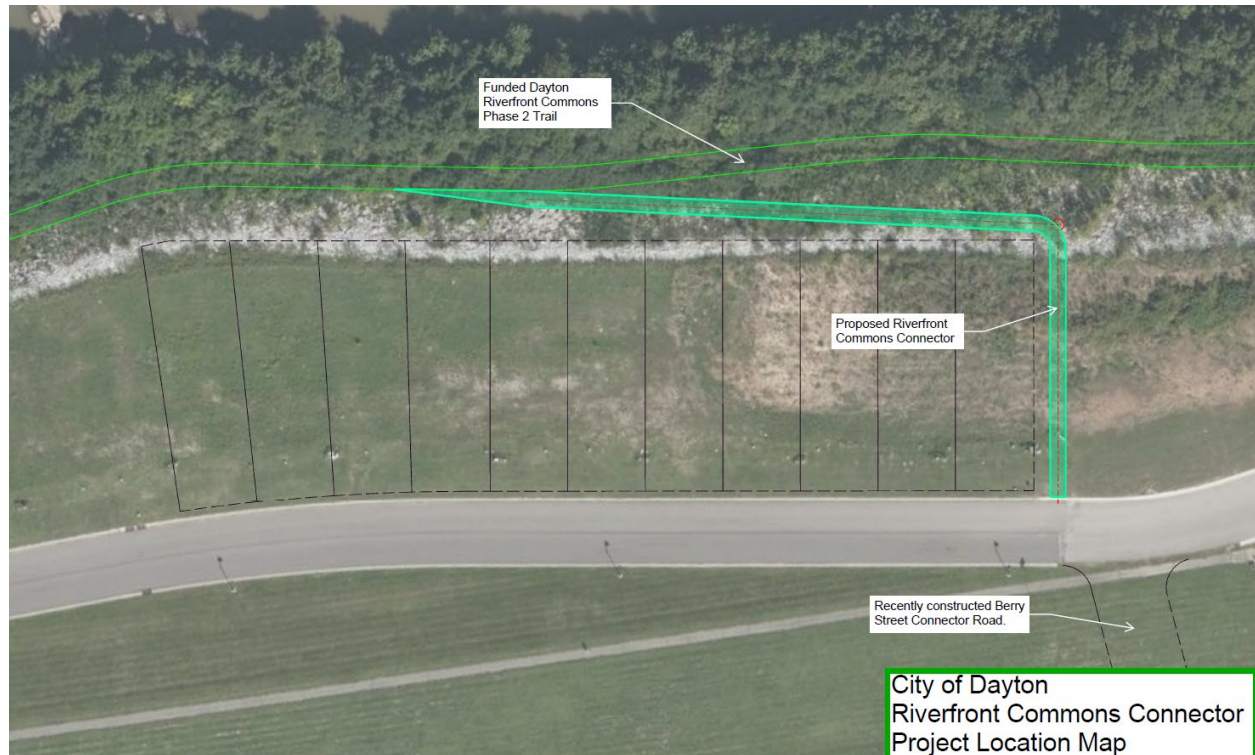
Cold Spring-US 27(Alexandria Pk)-Downing St. Realignment

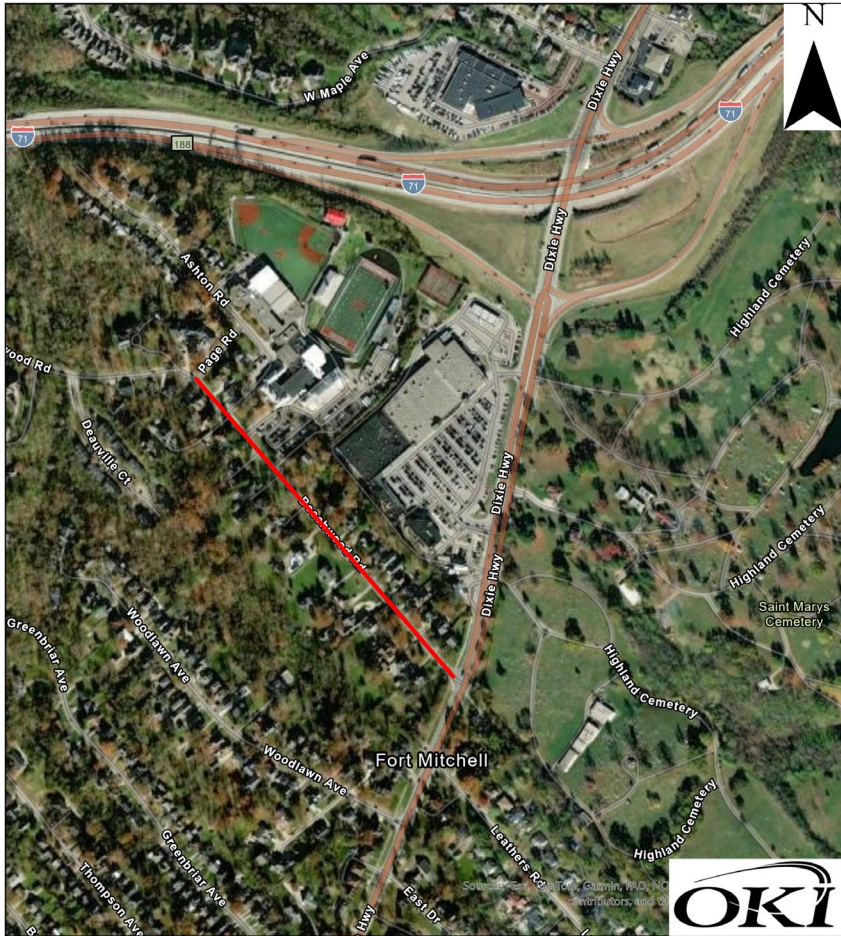

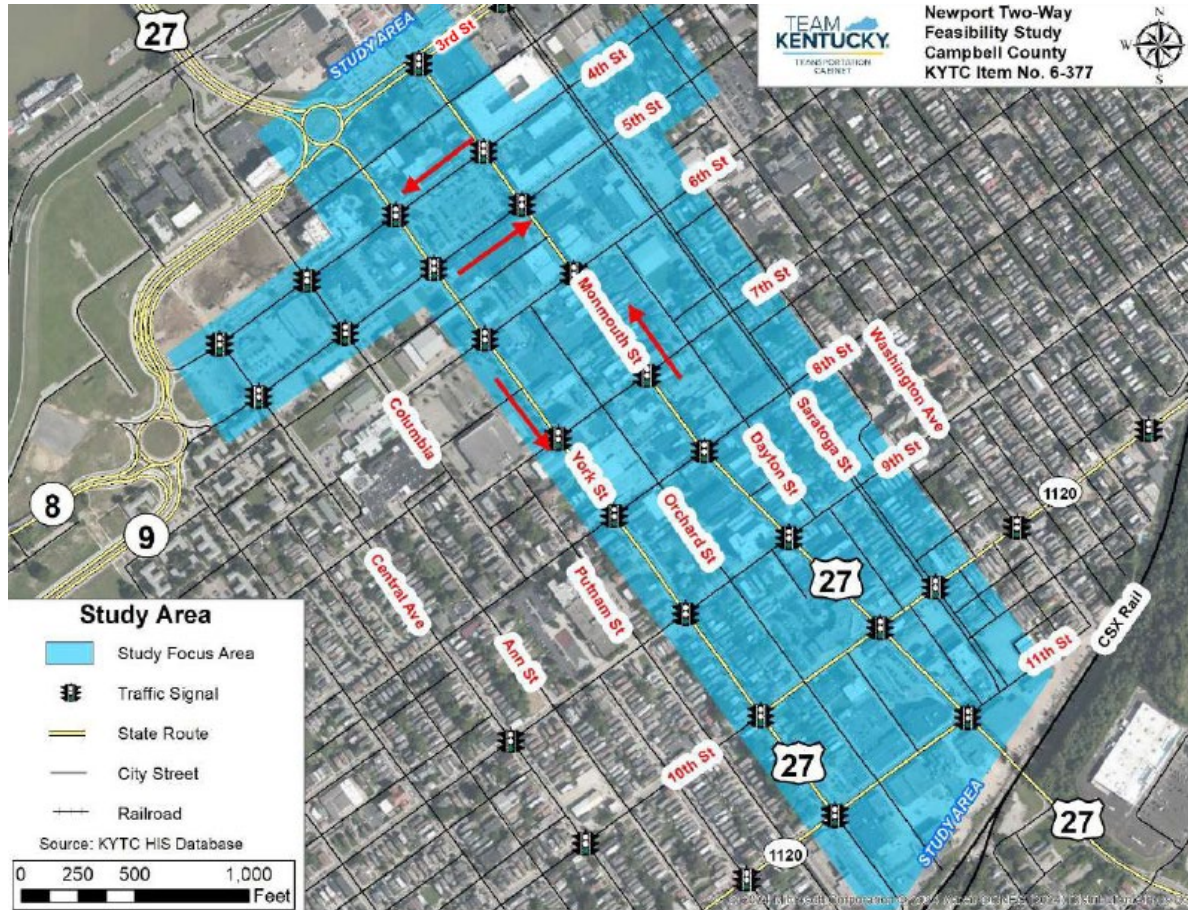

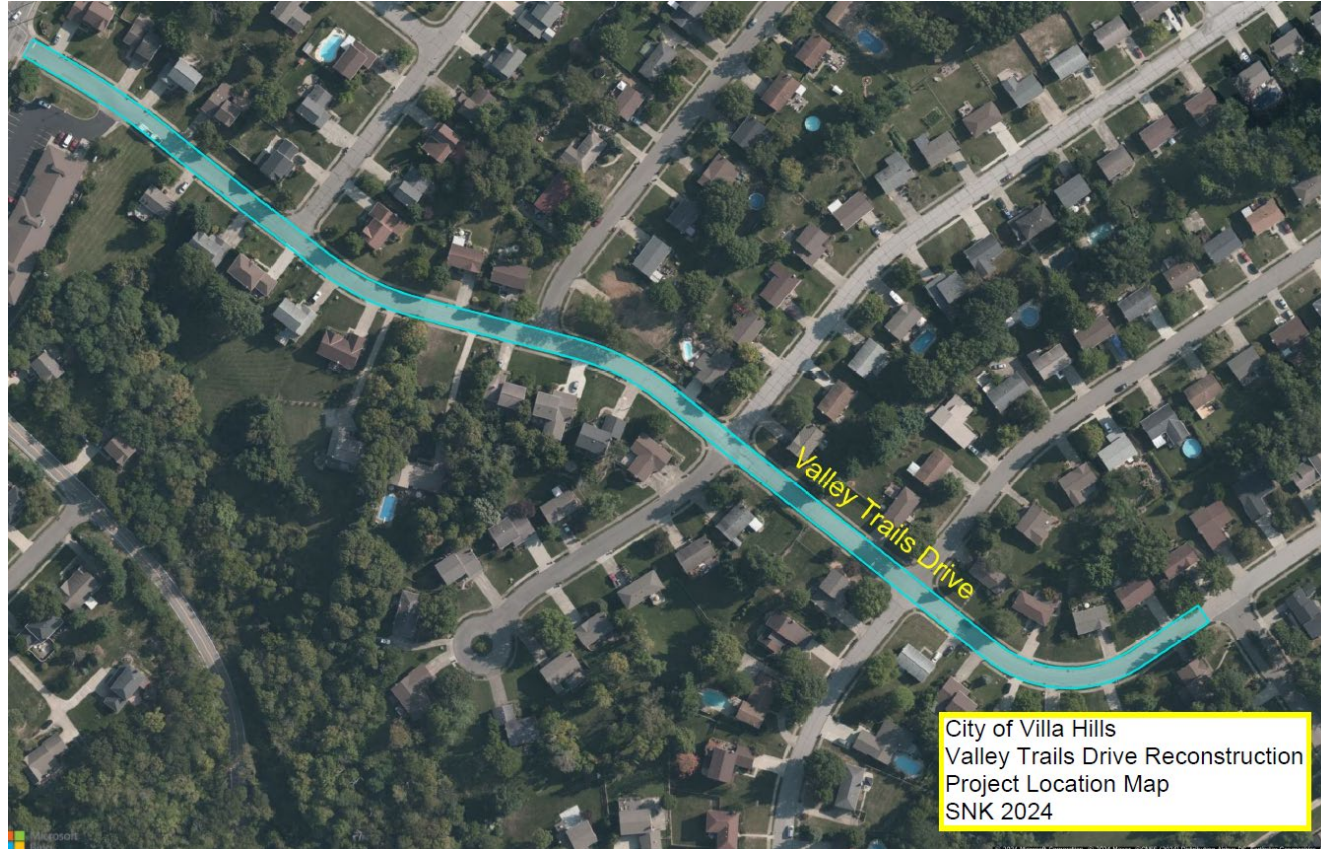

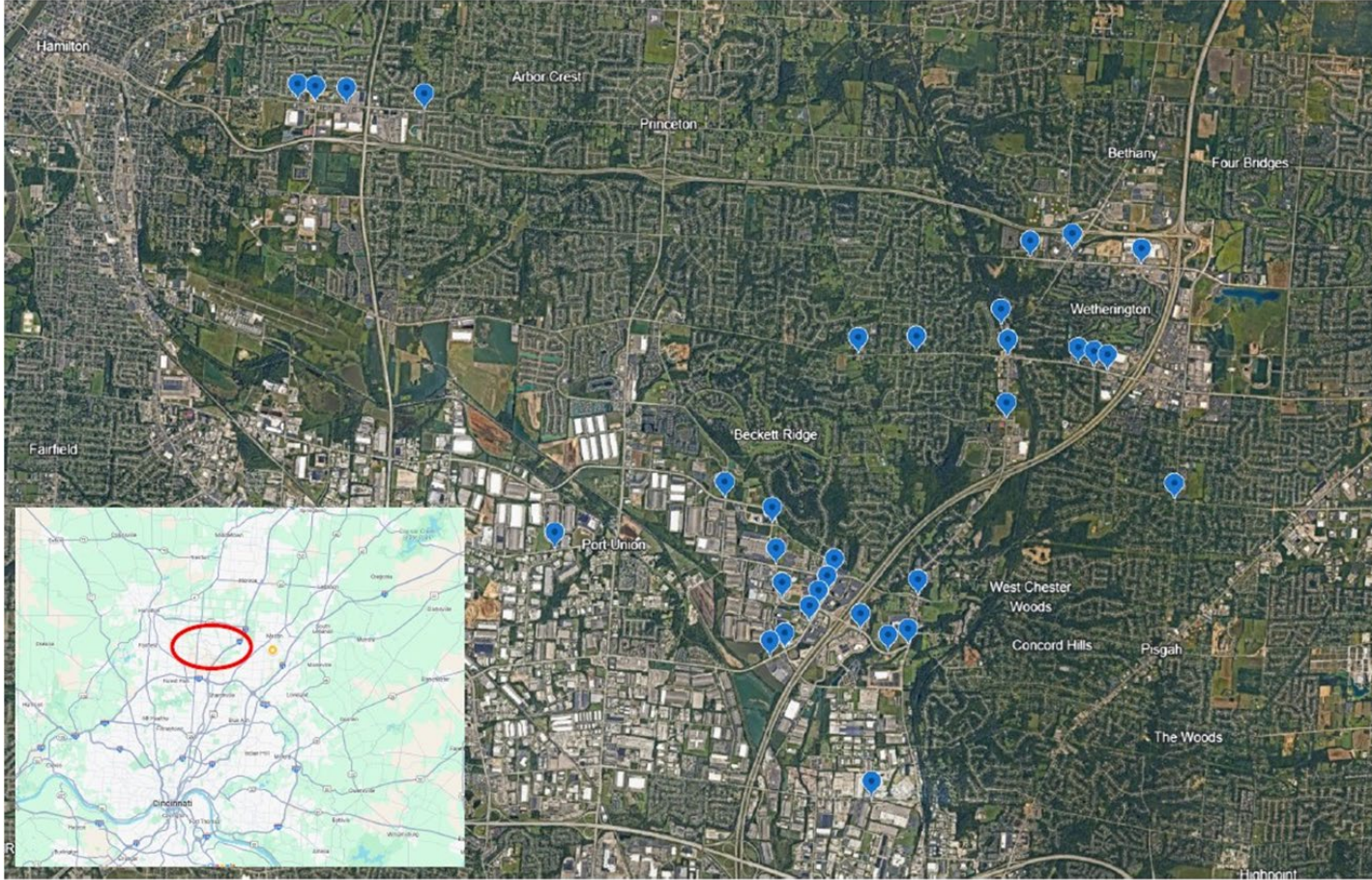

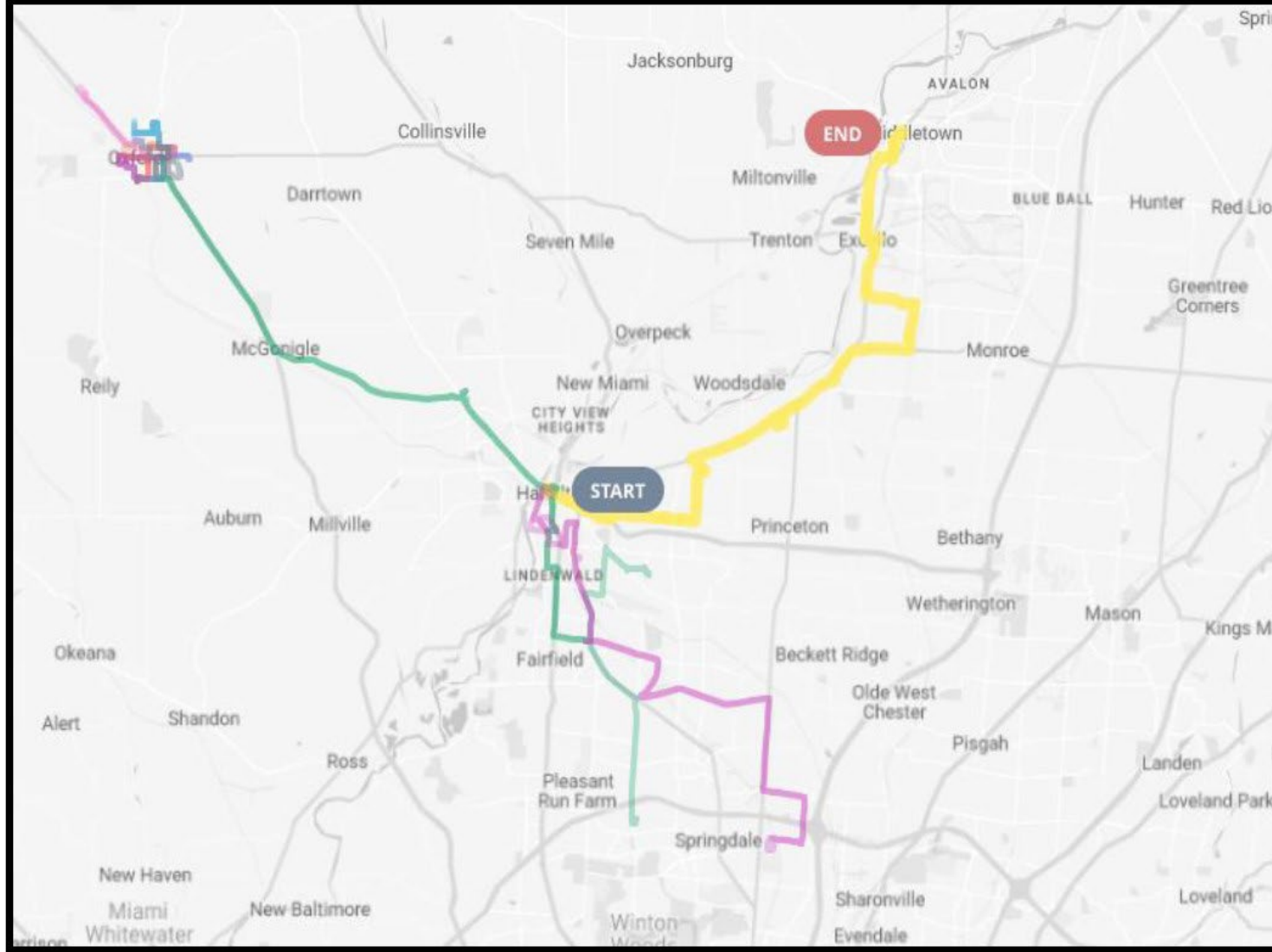

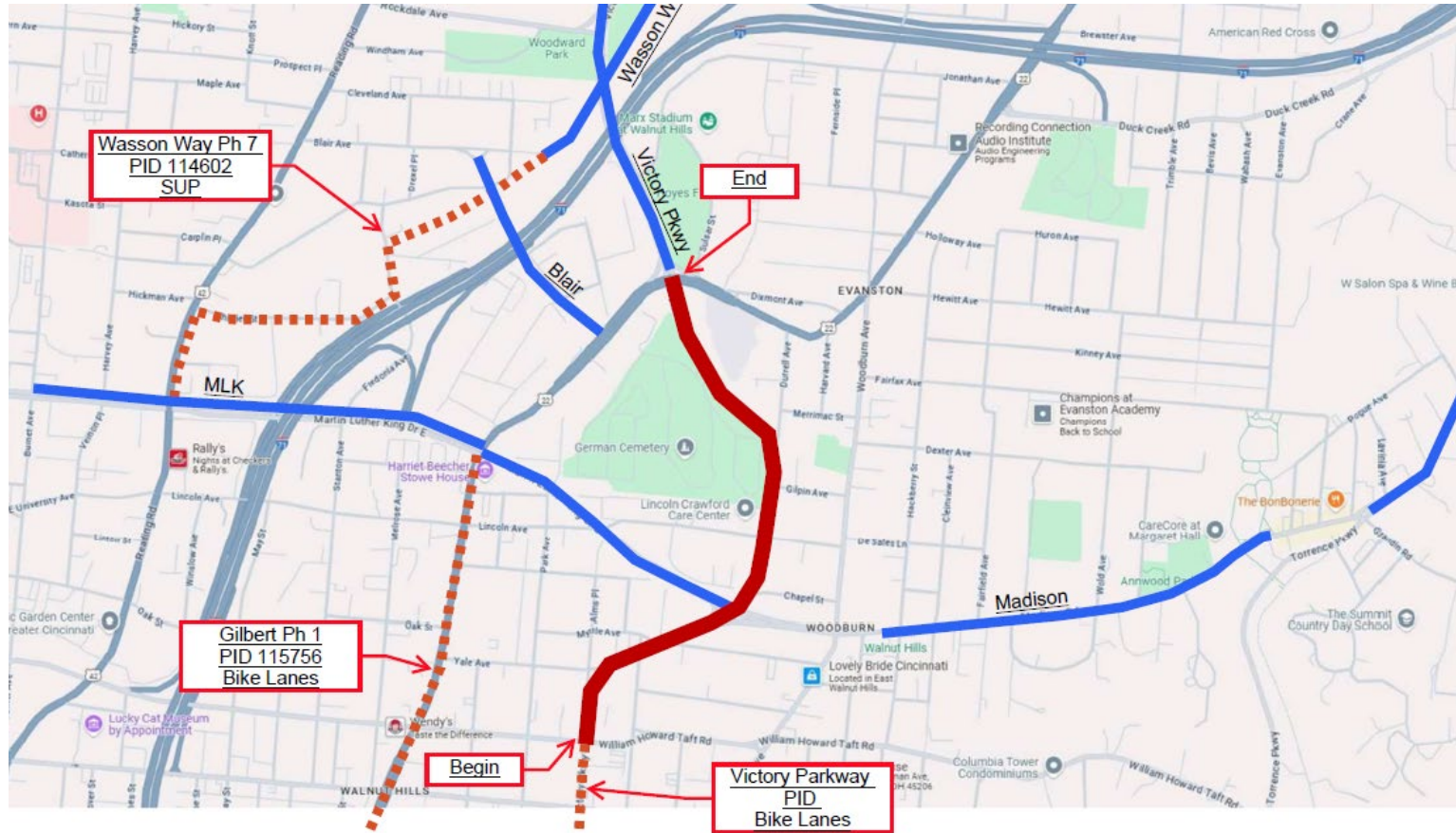

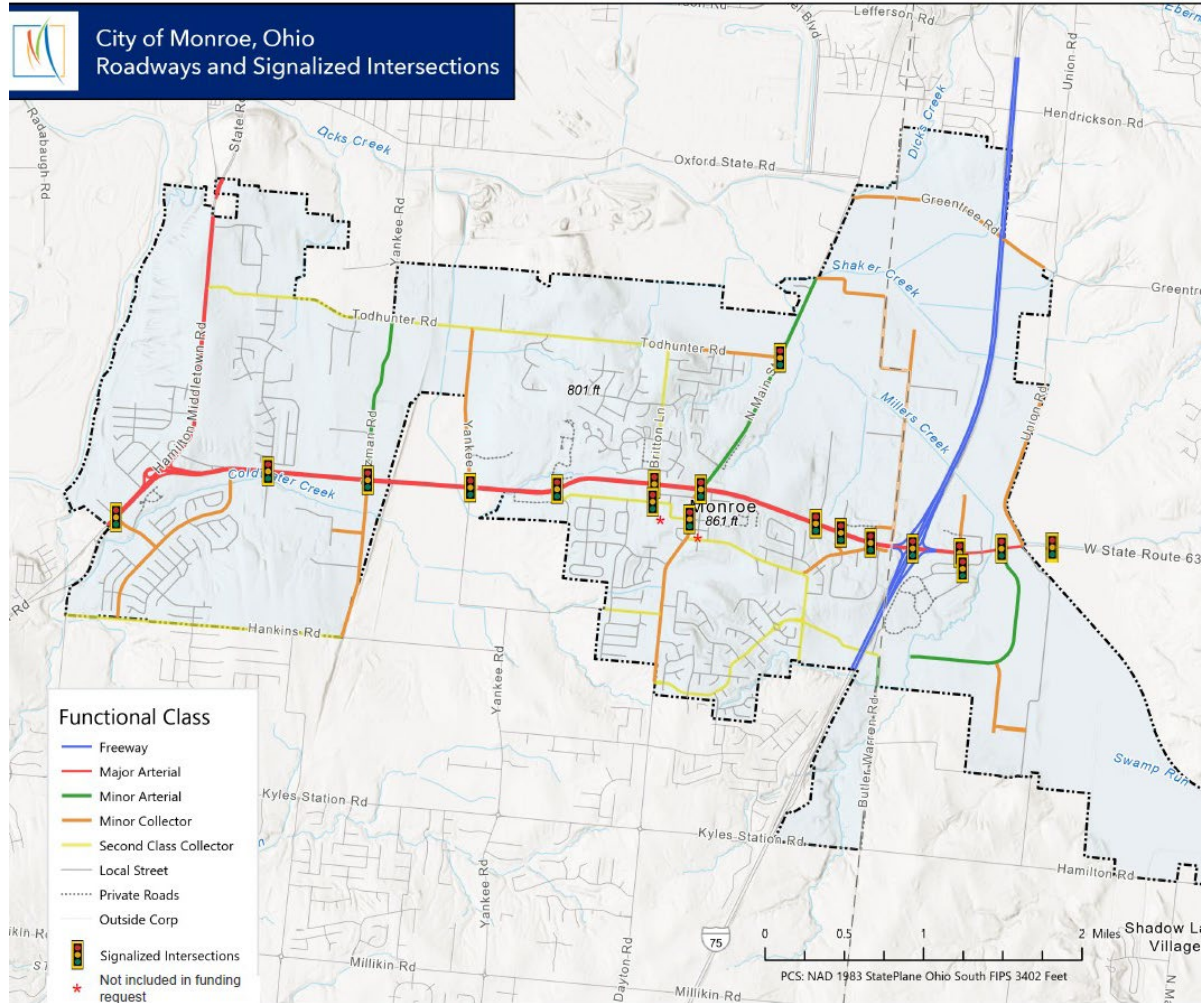

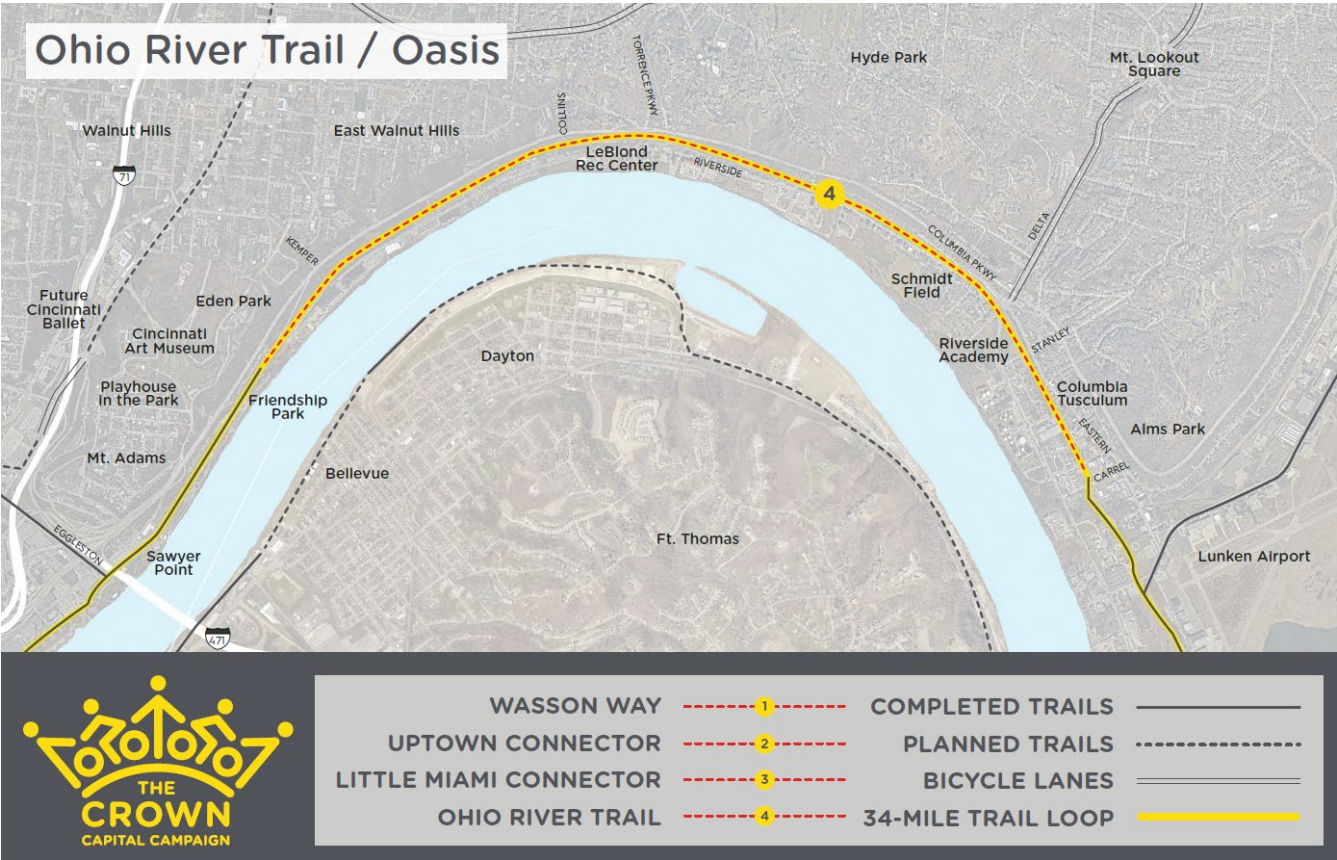

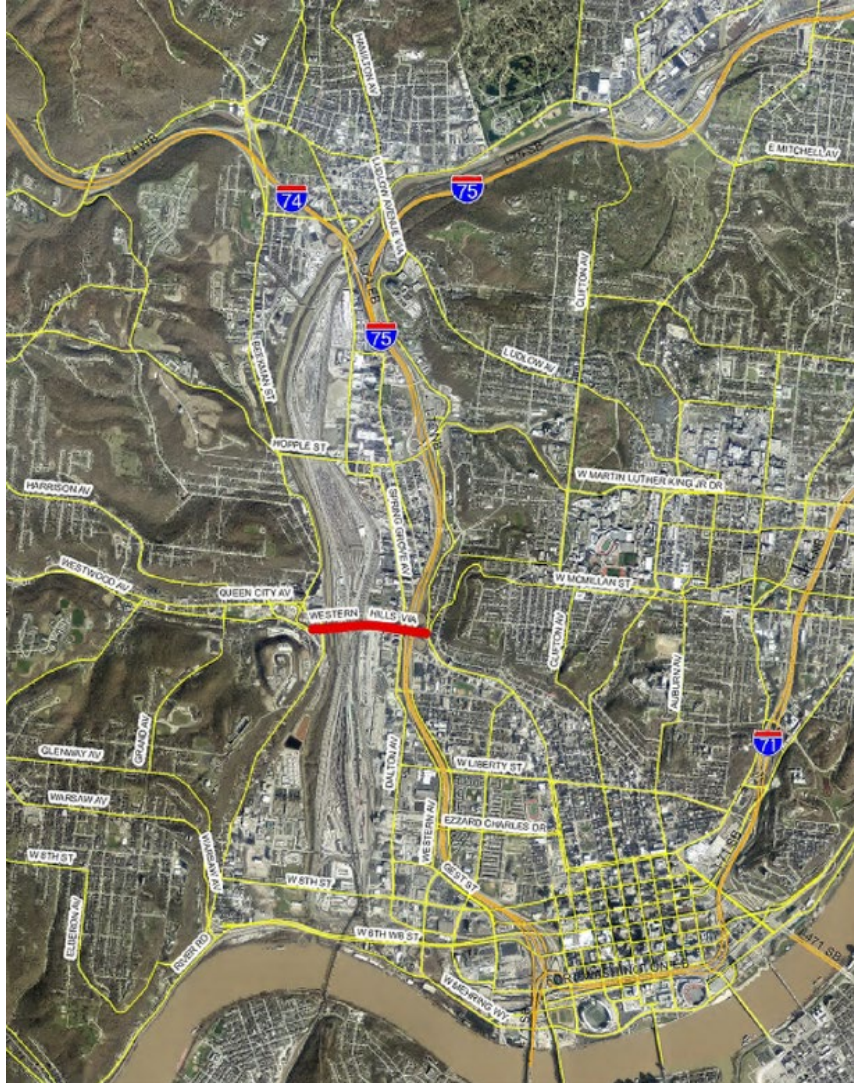

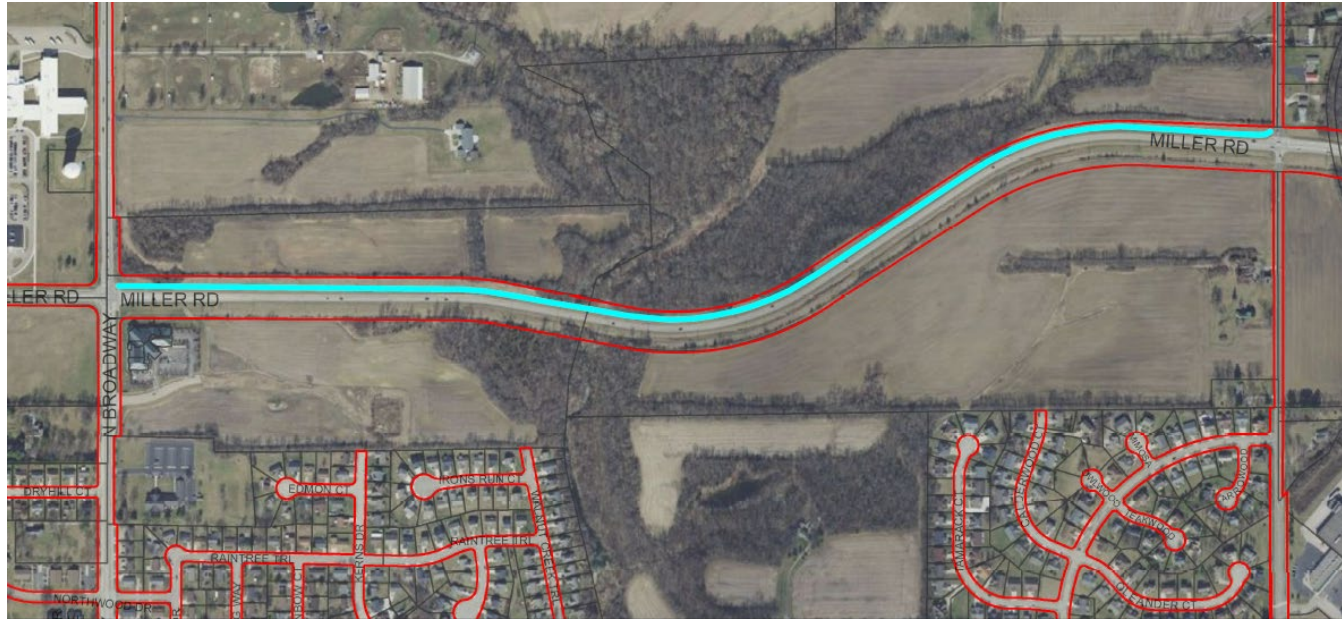

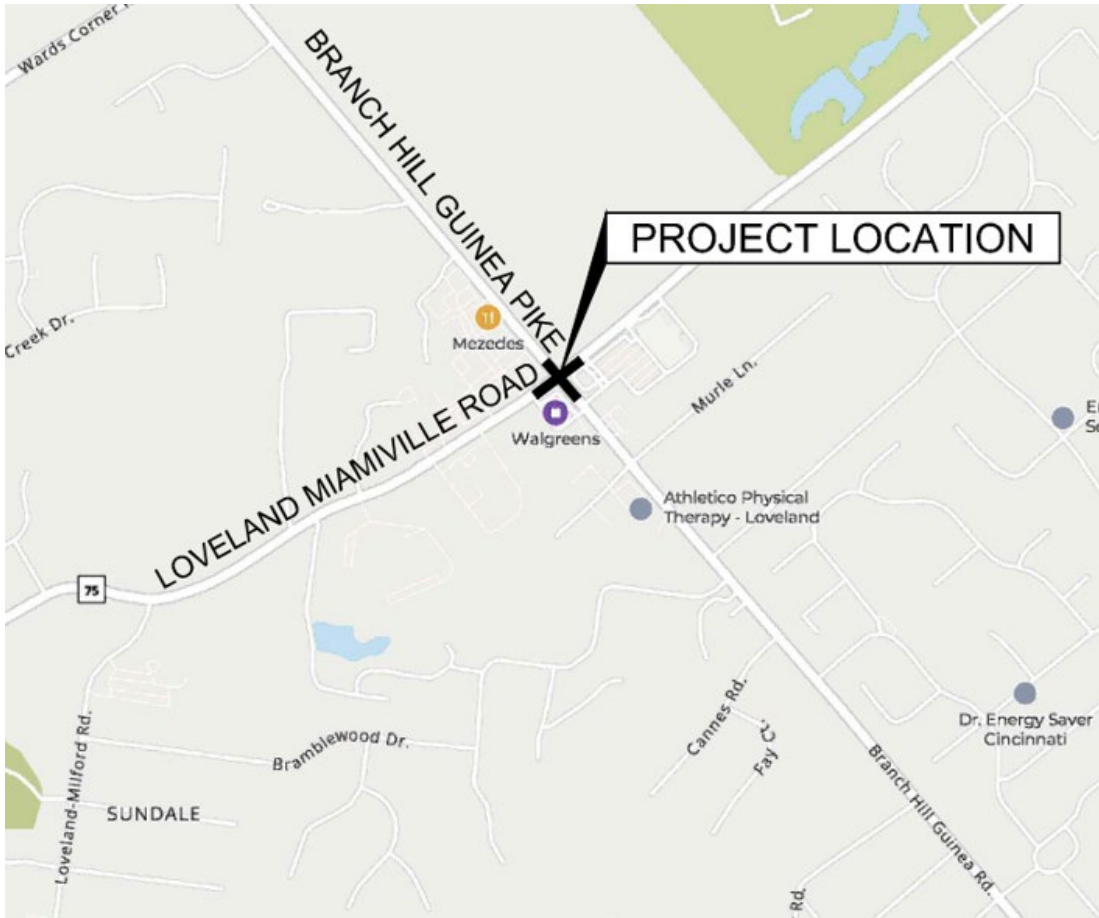

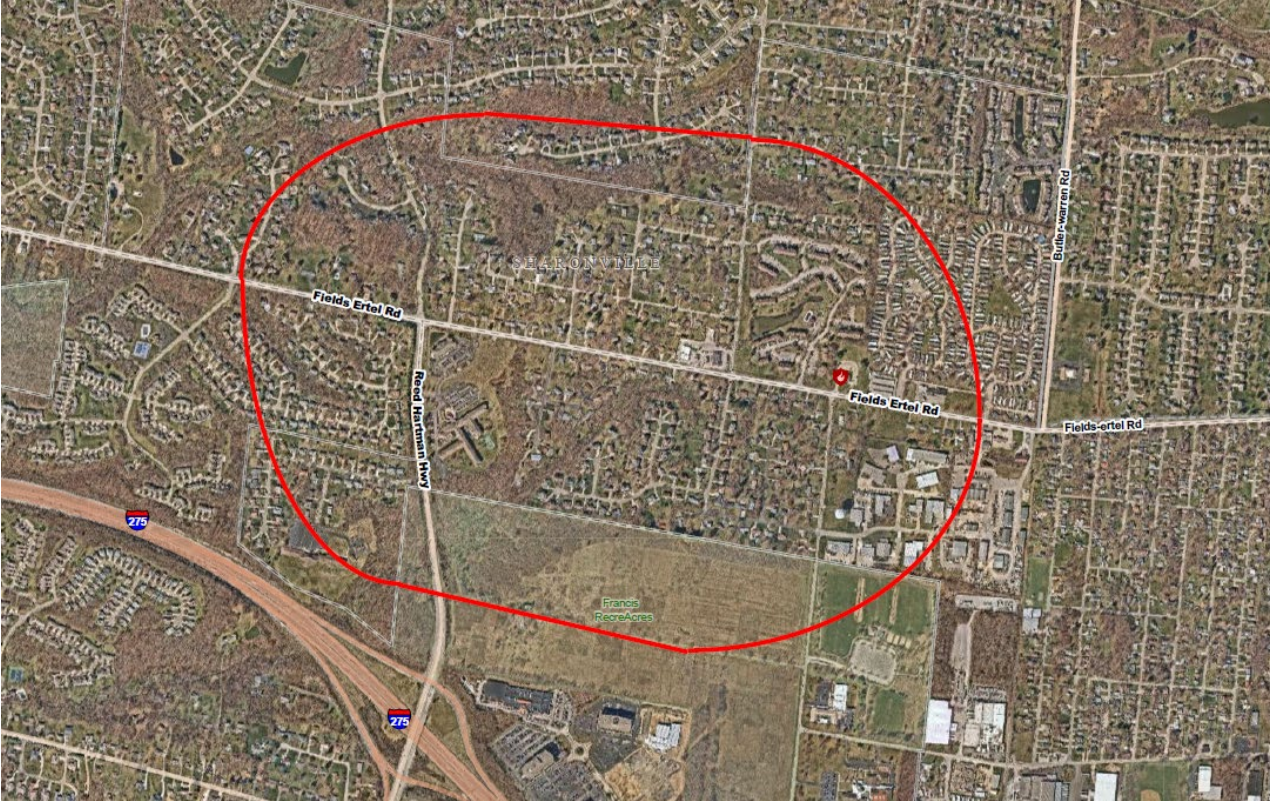

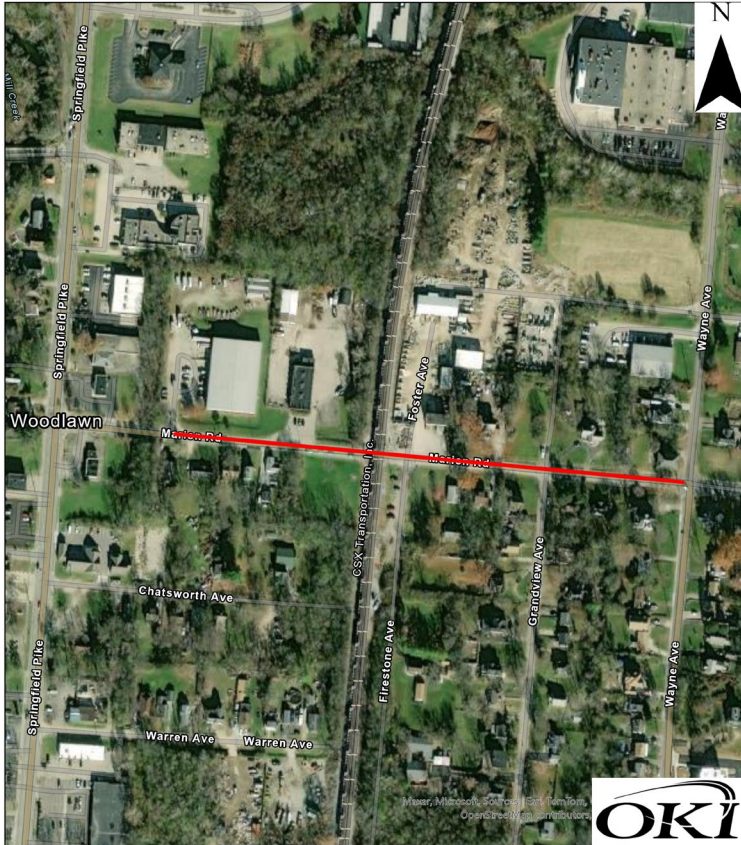
